JUROR

Jimmy Craig Womble - Born and raised in Rocky Mount, North Carolina, Jimmy Craig Womble announced his calling while he was in kindergarten - he knew he wanted to be an artist when he grew up. He got his official start in high school with paper and pencil and a serious knack for drawing. His painting career began while he was a student at North Carolina State University, where he graduated from the Design School.

Womble is an authentic contemporary impressionist painter who focuses on the rural landscapes, coastal and marine scenes Eastern Carolina. His career is marked with numerous solo exhibitions, travel, awards, and a strong sales record gaining him recognition in important permanent collections like the NC Bar Association.

"I paint that which has usually been overlooked by many as old, run down, or without value. Abandoned houses, old barns, rusty vehicles, and the detritus of a once thriving farming and fishing region find their way into many of my works. They tell a story of the south that I could never put into words. There will always be new things, but how long will I continue to be able to paint those reminders of what used to be? Both man and nature conspire against them, so I hoard their images in pads and on canvas."

Best in Show (1st place) \$350 plus either a solo or small group show (winner's choice) in June 2022.

Second Place \$250

Third Place \$150

Best by Caswell County Native or Resident \$100

HONORABLE MENTIONS MAY BE MADE AT THE JUROR'S DISCRETION, BUT CARRY NO MONETARY VALUE.

ENTRY FEES

Current members of Caswell Council for the Arts: \$20 per artist for a maximum of two pieces.

Non-members: \$30 per artist for a maximum of two pieces.

All entry fees are non-refundable.

ENTRIES

Entry does not guarantee acceptance. Limit of 2 entries per artist. All preliminary entries for the 2021 show will be digital. Photos of artwork will be accepted through our website at www.caswellarts.org/Juried-Art-Show/ Entries will be accepted beginning September 1, 2021.

All works will be allowed an overall image per submission, plus one detail image. Please make sure no mats or frames are visible in the overall image. Detailed close-up photos can highlight brushstrokes, color, etc.

Deadline for submissions is 2pm on October 1, 2021

NOTIFICATION

Notification of acceptance into the juried show will be individually emailed and also displayed on our website on Monday, October 11.

ACCEPTED SUBMISSIONS

This show is limited to **two-dimensional artwork**: Three dimensional work, photography and digital prints will not be accepted.

Caswell Arts reserves the right to reject any work that differs dramatically from the image submitted.

All entries must be completely original work by the entering artist, created within the **past three years**, and never previously entered in Caswell's Juried Art Show. Size should not exceed 24 inches in width by 36 inches in height.

All entries must be wired for hanging with eyehooks and wire. No sawtooth or clip mounting will be accepted. All works must have a permanent identification label with artist's name and title attached to the back of each piece.

All entries will be considered for sale unless otherwise noted. If you prefer not to sell your work, please write "NFS" on your entry.

SALES AND COMMISSIONS

Caswell Council for the Arts will encourage the sale of the exhibited works and will collect 25% commission on any member works and 35% on non-member works sold. All exhibiting artists are invited to become members. You do not have to be a Caswell County Resident to be a member of Caswell Arts.

If you are interested in becoming a member of Caswell Arts, membership is \$25 per year.

All accepted works, unless indicated NFS, will be displayed and available for sale through December 11, 2021.
